ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OLD BALDY FOUNDATION, INC.

I, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporator for the purposes of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT" and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

Article 1. NAME. The name of the corporation is OLD BALDY FOUNDATION, INC.

Article 2. <u>DURATION</u>. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

Article 3. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose for which this corporation is established is to maintain the historic lighthouse on Bald Head Island, Brunswick County, North Carolina and its surrounding grounds and appurtenant structures so as to preserve its historic, educational and architectural values in perpetuity.

Article 4. NON-MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION. The corporation is to have no members.

Article 5. <u>ELECTION OF DIRECTORS</u>. Directors of the corporation shall be elected in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

Article 6. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT. The address of the initial registered office for the corporation is as follows:

Article 7. INITIAL DIRECTORS. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be THREE (3) and the names and addresses of the persons serving until the first meeting of the corporation or until their successors are elected and qualified are as follows:

Article 8. <u>INCORPORATOR</u>. The name and address of the incorporator is as follows: W. A. Raney, Jr., 240 Princess Street, Post Office Box 1049, Wilmington, North Carolina 28402.

Article 9. <u>POWERS</u>. The corporation shall have all the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of North Carolina. However, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in the subsection of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 under which the corporation chooses to qualify for exemption, as the same now exists, or as it may be amended from time to time.

Article 10. DISTRIBUTION OR DISSOLUTION. No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes) and no member, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distributions of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations, as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or may hereafter by amended.

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation or the termination of its corporate existence, all its net assets located within the state of North Carolina shall be transferred, paid over, and delivered exclusively to or for the benefit of one or more scientific, charitable or educational organizations to be used and dedicated as nearly as practicable in accordance with the purposes of this corporation as set forth herein, provided that no such assets shall be distributed other than to or for the benefit of organizations or entities qualifying at the time of such distributions under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
